DAY CAMP QUESTIONS



1. What are the camp dates?

Camps are one week in length and begin June 28th with the last camp week beginning August 16th

2. What are the camp hours?

Camp is either 8:30-12:00 or 1:00-4:30 Monday thru Thursday. There is a specialty gymnastics camp each Friday from 9:00-12:00 followed by an Open Gym from 1:00-4:00. See our flyer for specific camp dates and times.

3. How much does it cost?

\$99.00 per camp. The Friday camp is \$30.00 for the ½ day.

4. Can I enroll for only certain days?

We do prefer that you enroll for a week at a time. If the schedule permits we can allow daily enrollment.

5. Is there a fee if I arrive late for pick up?

Yes, \$1.00 per minute after 12:00 or 4:00.

6. What is the student/teacher ratio?

Our student/teacher ratio is 12:1

7. Who are your teachers? What are their qualifications? Do they have teaching certificates?

Our KIDS WORLD Director has a Masters Degree in Education along with a Professional Teaching Certificate. All other staff members are safety certified and carry a bachelor's degree in education or other related field.

8. What is the curriculum your school program will follow? If my children need tutoring in a specific subject can your teachers help with that?

Our curriculum for the summer is “Around the World in 45 days.” We will study a different country each week. Throughout the week we will be studying their culture, traditions, food, history, celebrations, sports, science, climate, etc. Each child will be creating a passport to travel with them throughout the summer. If your child needs tutoring in a specific area, please contact the office to make separate arrangements.

9. If my child is sick and misses a class are there any make-ups?

Generally, there are not make-ups. Please call the office if your child is sick and cannot attend camp.

10. Is there a discount for more than one child enrolled in the program?

There is a 10% discount for additional children enrolled. There is also a discount if you pay for camp a month at a time.

11. Do you provide snacks and drinks?

All food and drinks are provided by the parent.

12. If my child is enrolled in full day do they get a nap?

We do not take naps. There is a break between the morning and afternoon camp.

13. Will the children be separated by age?

The children will be separated by age if the enrollment allows as such. However, if there is not a separation of children, age appropriate activities are done daily with each age group.

14. How is the day spent? Provide a breakdown of a typical day.

15. How do you handle discipline?

There are 4 steps for behavioral issues. The 1st is a general warning; the 2nd is a warning which will include a short exclusion of activity; the 3rd is a notification to the parent at the end of the day; the 4th is a conference with the Director, camper and parent.

16. Will there be field trips? If yes, how will you transport the children?

Yes. There will be a weekly field trip. If there is transportation involved, you will be notified at least one week prior. Depending on the nature of the field trip, there may be an additional cost.

17. What is the dress code?

We ask the kids to wear shirts and shorts (comfortable clothing). Bring a change of clothes each day. Your child is required to wear their KIDS WORLD T-shirt when field trips are off-site.

18. What is the age ranges of the kids who can enroll?

The age range of children who can enroll is 4-13 years old.

19. Is there a program at the end of the session to review my child's progress and show case his/her skills?

At the end of the summer we will be having a program/open house to showcase what & where we have travelled throughout the summer.
